Unitab Enterprise Bargaining Agreement endorsed by staff

Unitab staff voted to endorse the ASU EBA. The ballot result declares that the ASU EBA has been approved by the majority of staff who voted.

The official ballot results are as follows:

514 employees were eligible to vote and receive a ballot paper
212 employees voted in the secret ballot
187 employees voted in favour of the Agreement.
25 employees voted against the Agreement.
1 invalid vote was cast.

What happens next?

Unitab and the ASU are currently finalising all documentation. It has been signed by ASU and returned to Unitab Human Resource Manager Evelyn Sullivan for lodgement with the Workplace Authority. Once lodgement occurs the EBA commences.

Once the EBA has been lodged and accepted by the Workplace Authority the Unitab pay office can adjust wage rates and calculate back pay owed to individual staff. The precise timing of wage increases and back-pay will be advised shortly.

We have been able to secure:

A four percent (4%) pay increase back paid from November 2007

Further increases totalling 11% over the life of the agreement, i.e.:

4% paid November 2008
3.5% paid November 2009
3.5% paid November 2010

A March 2011 expiry date.
