MEMBERS OF THE ASU CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN QUEENSLAND BRANCH EMPLOYED BY ERGON ENERGY WILL BE PARTICIPATING IN A 48 HOUR STOP WORK NEXT WEEK.

This stop work is being held in conjunction with the other unions of the SBU. Rallies will be held in major centres around the state.

Details of the rallies will be communicated to members as soon as they have been finalised.

The 48 hour stop work has been organised in response to the resounding response of members from all unions in relation to the Ergon Energy Revised Offer.

Members at all Ergon workplace meetings overwhelmingly rejected Ergon Energy's revised offer.

All members of the Union need to participate in this stop work to demonstrate to Ergon Energy and the Queensland State Government that their offer fails to address the concerns that have been continually raised and that members are not willing to trade off conditions or jeopardise safety for a 1.5% superannuation contribution increase.
