Airport Updates

AGH

As a result of the ITEAs that Aviation Ground Handling (AGH) staff signed for employment not passing the No Disadvantage Test (NDT), staff are now being paid under Award conditions until their new Collective Agreement is assessed against the NDT.

The Workplace Ombudsman has instructed AGH to calculate and backpay staff who were on the failed ITEAs.

Oceania

Meetings between representatives from the Australian Services Union (ASU) and the Management of Oceania concerning the Enterprise Bargaining Agreement (EBA) are continuing. The next meeting is scheduled for 25th August, 2009.

Australian Air Express (AaE)

EBA negotiating meetings between the ASU, Staff Representatives and Management restarted on Friday 21 August, 2009 and another meeting is scheduled within the week beginning 31 August, 2009.
