APN Update

Your union, the Australian Services Union (ASU), met with APN Management and their Industrial advisors to discuss your Collective Agreement on Thursday, 4 February, 2010.

APN has put forward that they would be seeking to leave the Collective Agreement framework and go over to the new modern Private Sector Clerical Award.

Your Union's answer was that if this was to be entertained, that above award provisions like redundancy would have to be protected and if staff were being paid more than the award, that they could not be disadvantaged under a legally binding document like a Memorandum of Understanding.

APN agreed that no staff member would be disadvantaged under this process.

Your Union also raised the issue that staff had not been given a pay rise for a significant time now and that members want a pay rise.

APN agreed that they would look into this as part of developing a Memorandum of Understanding.

The ASU also highlighted the need to ensure that people were being paid at the right level.

APN also agreed to incorporate this into the Memorandum of Understanding.

The meeting finished with ASU agreeing to review the Memorandum of Understanding once it was drawn up by APN.
