Collective Agreement Negotiations Update

ASU Official, Kevin Place and ASU Delegate, Christine Collyer attended a Collective Agreement Negotiation meeting held on Thursday 10th December, 2009.

The discussions in this meeting were regarding the following:

LOG OF CLAIMS

The ASU along with the other unions, clarified each of the points in their log of claims and discussions are currently occurring regarding these key points.

SICK LEAVE

Discussions were held regarding the Leave Modernisation Package which is one aspect of the Council's claim. BCC has proposed to change the sick leave provisions from a safety net sick leave package to a hybrid scheme. The hybrid scheme incorporates accumulating sick leave and safety net provisions.

No agreement has been reached regarding your sick leave provisions. The ASU will not agree to anything that provides less than the entitlements members currently have available.

Consultation will continue with ASU members so you are aware of the nature of discussions prior to any decisions made by the ASU.

NEXT NEGOTIATION MEETING

The negotiations have now ceased until the 1st and 2nd February, 2010. Numerous key players involved in the negotiations were

unavailable prior to this date. From this date forward two full day meetings will be held weekly between Management and the relevant Unions.
