What Level Are You Classified At and Do You Agree With This Classification?

It has come to the attention of the ASU that there were a number of Healthscope Hospitals who failed to notify the Administration Staff of the Ballot results of the recently negotiated Collective Agreement.

Due of the failure of some of the General Managers to undertake this task, the Australian Service Union contacted Senior Healthscope Management to request that the 28 day timeframe for staff to apply for reclassification consideration be extended.

This request has been granted and Administration staff now have until the 5th of March 2010 to complete a Change of Status Form.

If successful, staff will be back paid from 25 January, 2010.

If you feel that you have been classified at an incorrect level, the ASU encourages you to complete this form.

ASU Officials Sandra Leggieri & Rana Watson will be visiting sites over the next two weeks, so please take the time to speak with them during these visits.
