Your Legal Rights

Under the Fair Work Act 2009, you have the legal right to be a union member. Your employer cannot discriminate against you because of your union membership or because you ask the union for help. You have the right to be represented at work for any matter. As an ASU member, you are legally protected in your workplace!

As A Union Member You Have:

- Access to collective resources to protect and defend your rights
- Defence against unlawful dismissal and victimisation
- Access to experienced Union Officials and Delegates for confidential advice and a fair go for you in your workplace
- The right to actively participate in and be informed on issues which affect you in your employment

The Australian Services Union would like to advise all Jetstar employees at the Brisbane and Coolangatta Airports the Jetstar/ASU Agreement 2007 expires on 30 September, 2010.

It is crucial we maintain majority union membership before going into this bargaining period.
