Mater Private Hospital Collective Agreement

PAID MEETINGS

Negotiations continue regarding your replacement Collective Agreement. Mater Management have consulted with a costing analyst to evaluate the ASU Log of Claims and have now made an offer to your ASU representatives for consideration by Mater Private employee's.

This offer included the proposed yearly increase, reclassification process and mandatory clauses. Mater Management agreed that ASU members and employees need to be consulted so feed back can be provided at the next negotiating meeting.

There are still numerous issues tabled in our Log of Claims that Management have not acknowledged and this needs to be discussed with members to gain feedback and determine a strategy for negotiations.

It is crucial that all Administration staff attend one of the paid report back meetings so that you understand what Mater Management are offering employees and to provide feedback to your ASU representatives on crucial issues.

To ensure that as many Administrative and Clerical staff as possible can attend, there are a range of meetings that have been scheduled so that you can have your say.

Mater Management and supervisors are aware that paid meetings are a necessary part of this process and have agreed that if staff request to attend that they will be released for a one hour paid break to allow them to attend.
