Mater Private Hospital Negotiations Update

The initial Mater Private Hospital negotiation meeting was held on the 2nd February, 2010 between the Australian Services Union, Mater Private Hospital Management and two appointed bargaining representatives from your workplace. The Australian Services Union was represented by ASU Organisers, Nicky Lindsay and Sandra Leggieri and two Mater Private Hospital Workplace Delegates, Wendy Varady and Susan Cooper.

At this meeting the ASU tabled our Log of Claims. This was endorsed by ASU members at paid meetings. The following points were tabled at the meeting for negotiation.

1. Parity with Mater Public pay rates
2. Recognition of Service – pay increment levels
3. Increase in Uniform allowance/allocation
4. Yearly pay increase (5%)
5. Payout option for sick leave
6. Penalty rates increase – shift work
7. Extra week annual leave for 24 hour facilities
8. Career structure
9. Training opportunities
10. Paid meal break on night duties
11. Consultation clause
12. Flexibility clause
13. Dispute Resolution clause
14. Union Encouragement clause

The next meeting with Mater Private Hospital Management will be held on Thursday the 11th of February, 2010. At this meeting the Mater Private Hospital bargaining representatives will be tabling their Log of Claims.

It is through Union membership that we are able to negotiate with the Mater Private Hospital Management from a position of strength and we would therefore encourage and invite any non-union members to join the ASU.
